**Executive Order 14014 of February 10, 2021  
Blocking Property With Respect to the Situation in Burma**

**GENERAL LICENSE NO. 2**

**Official Activities of Certain International Organizations and Other International Entities**

(a) Except as provided in paragraph (b) of this general license, all transactions and activities prohibited by Executive Order (E.O.) 14014 that are for the conduct of the official business of the following entities, by employees, grantees, or contractors thereof are authorized:

(1) The United Nations, including its Programmes, Funds, and Other Entities and Bodies, as well as its Specialized Agencies and Related Organizations;

(2) International Centre for Settlement of Investment Disputes (ICSID) and the Multilateral Investment Guarantee Agency (MIGA);

(3) The African Development Bank Group, the Asian Development Bank, the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development, and the Inter-American Development Bank Group (IDB Group), including any fund entity administered or established by any of the foregoing;

(4) International Committee of the Red Cross and the International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies;

(5) International Development Law Organization (IDLO);

(6) The Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN);

(7) The Colombo Plan;

(8) The Consultative Group on International Agricultural Research (CGIAR) System Organization and the International Agricultural Research Centers supported by the CGIAR;

(9) The Extractive Industries Transparency Initiative (EITI); and

(10) The Global Fund to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis, and Malaria and the Global Alliance for Vaccines and Immunizations.

(b) This general license does not authorize any transactions or activities otherwise prohibited by E.O. 14014, or prohibited by any part of 31 CFR chapter V, statute, or other Executive order.
