Alaska

Treasury approves Alaska's plan to invest \$20 million of CPF funding in a multi-purpose community facility to improve resources for communities that enable work, education, and health monitoring.

Alaska Capital Projects Fund Program Overview

- **Program Summary:** \$20 million for Multi-Purpose Community Facilities (18% of CPF allocation)
- **Program Description:** The expansion and renovation of the Iliuliuk Family and Health Services Center will create additional space for clinical and expanded primary care services, and provide space dedicated to multi-purpose community use. The renovated center will provide public access to free internet service with equipment needed for youth and adults to access on-line educational courses and career programming. The center serves the remote community of Unalaska/Dutch Harbor.
- **Key State Contact:** Iliuliuk Family & Health Services (IFHS)

Alaska estimates this center will benefit approximately 5,000 individuals annually.
