Alaska

Treasury approves Alaska's plan to invest \$9 million of CPF funding in a multi-purpose community facility to improve resources for communities that enable work, education, and health monitoring.

Alaska Capital Projects Fund Program Overview

- **Program Summary:** \$9 million for a Multi-Purpose Community Facility (8% of CPF allocation)
- **Program Description:** The expansion of the Yukon-Kuskokwim Fitness Center (YKFC), a multi-use community facility owned and operated by the City of Bethel, will result in a larger space for the community to hold events, which are expected to include workforce development trainings, education services, health screenings, and recreational events. Additionally, the YKFC will provide a computer lab equipped with internet, computers, and printers to the public to access education and work opportunities, as well as dedicated private space to access online telehealth appointments.

The facility is estimated to benefit over 6,000 community members in the City of Bethel as well as residents in the surrounding Yukon-Kuskokwim Delta.
