



# Capital Projects Fund Award Fact Sheet

## Tennessee

*Treasury approves Tennessee's plan to invest \$185 million of CPF funding in broadband infrastructure projects that will provide high-quality internet to locations that lack access to adequate service.*

### Tennessee Capital Projects Fund Program Overview

- **Program Summary:** \$185 million for Broadband Infrastructure (86% of CPF allocation)
- **Locations to Be Served:** 50,000 (estimated)
- **Program Description:** Tennessee will implement two broadband infrastructure programs that aim to provide reliable internet access in areas of the state lacking adequate service. Tennessee's Last Mile Connection program is a competitive grant program designed to provide service to remote areas of the state where broadband infrastructure projects would not be feasible without assistance. Tennessee's Middle Mile Buildout Program is a competitive grant program designed to deploy middle mile infrastructure in rural areas of the state to improve and expand last mile connections.
  - The program is designed to provide internet service with speeds of 100/100 Mbps symmetrical to households and businesses upon project completion.
  - Each of the internet service providers funded by the program will participate in the FCC's [Affordable Connectivity Program \(ACP\)](#) – a \$30 per month subsidy for low-income families.

*As reported by Tennessee, estimates show that investments made using the Capital Projects Fund will serve ~11% of locations still lacking high-speed internet access in the state.*
