



# Capital Projects Fund Award Fact Sheet

## Wyoming

*Treasury approves Wyoming's plan to invest \$70.5 million of CPF funding in broadband infrastructure projects that will provide high-quality internet to locations that lack access to adequate service.*

### Wyoming Capital Projects Fund Program Overview

- **Program Summary:** \$70.5 million for Broadband Infrastructure (64% of CPF allocation)
- **Locations to Be Served:** 11,700 (estimated)
- **Program Description:** The Connect Wyoming grant program is a competitive grant program designed to fund last mile broadband infrastructure projects in areas throughout the state that currently lack access to internet at speeds of 100/20 Mbps to facilitate access to work, education, and health monitoring.
  - The program is designed to provide internet service with speeds of 100/100 Mbps symmetrical to households and businesses upon project completion.
  - Each of the internet service providers funded by the program will participate in the FCC's [Affordable Connectivity Program \(ACP\)](#) – a \$30 per month subsidy for low-income families.

*As reported by Wyoming, estimates show that investments made using the Capital Projects Fund will serve ~20% of locations still lacking high-speed internet access in the state.*
