GENERAL OVERVIEW

Executive Summary

Through June 30, 2022 Broward County has used \$378,707,907 of the federal assistance provided through the State Local Fiscal Recovery Fund to replace lost revenue due to the COVID-19 public health emergency. The funds are being used to provide government services across a range of county agencies, personnel costs, and other operating costs.

Broward County plans to utilize the remaining balance of \$596,327 for the provision of government services by September 30, 2022.

Uses of Funds

The County's use of the funds focused on the following Expenditure Areas:

6. Revenue Replacement (EC6)

6.1 Provision of Government Services

Broward County used the Local Fiscal Recovery Funds for the provision of government services, across a range of County agencies, for personnel costs and other operating costs.

As noted in the April 2022 update to the original Recovery Plan, Broward County has refined its use of federal assistance through the State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund to the provision of government services to the extent of the reduction in revenue due to the COVID–19 public health emergency relative to revenues collected in the most recent full fiscal year prior to the emergency.

As of June 30, 2022 Broward County had expended \$378,707,907 of the SLFRF allocation for the provision of government services.

The County has calculated its revenue loss based upon guidance provided by the U.S. Department of the Treasury. Revenue loss for fiscal years 2020 and 2021 were as follows:

- Revenue Loss for fiscal year 2020 was \$305.8 million
- Revenue Loss for fiscal year 2021 is approximately \$ 571.5 million.
