Treasury approves Colorado's plan to invest \$48.7 million of CPF funding in a multi-purpose community facility to improve resources for communities that enable work, education, and health monitoring.

Colorado Capital Projects Fund Program Overview

- **Program Summary:** \$48.7 million for a Multi-Purpose Community Facility (28.5% of CPF allocation)
- **Program Description:** Colorado is building the Ridge View Supportive Residential Community (RVSRC) Facility to provide low-barrier access to comprehensive vocational services, and treatment to support people experiencing homelessness. Services offered at RVSRC will include education, training and employment placement, primary care, behavioral health outpatient treatment, and health monitoring. The facility will be open to the public.

The facility is estimated to serve over 1,000 individuals annually.
