

## Capital Projects Fund Award Fact Sheet New Hampshire

Treasury approves New Hampshire's plan to invest \$26 million of CPF funding in broadband infrastructure programs to provide high-speed internet to locations that lack access to adequate service.

## **New Hampshire Capital Projects Fund Program Overview**

- Program Summary: \$26 million for Broadband Infrastructure (21% of CPF allocation)
- Program Description: New Hampshire's Broadband Matching Grant Initiative (BMGI), a competitive grant program, is the state's second broadband infrastructure program funded by CPF. The BMGI is designed to fund broadband infrastructure projects to bring high-speed internet to areas currently lacking service of 100/20 Mbps. The BMGI will provide a state match that is designed to alleviate the fiscal impact of community-driven broadband investment for both ISPs and municipalities and reduce reliance on bonding.
  - The program is designed to provide internet service with speeds of 100/100 Mbps symmetrical to households and businesses upon project completion.
  - Each of the ISPs funded by the program will participate in the FCC's <u>Affordable</u>
    <u>Connectivity Program (ACP)</u> a \$30 per month subsidy for low-income families.
