## Connecticut

*Treasury approves Connecticut's plan to invest \$20 million of CPF funding in a multi-purpose community facility to improve resources for communities that enable work, education, and health monitoring.*

### Connecticut's Capital Projects Fund Program Overview

- **Program Summary:** \$20 million for Multi-Purpose Community Facilities (14% of CPF allocation)
- **Program Description:** Connecticut will use this CPF award to fund the renovation and expansion of the New Haven Adult & Continuing Education Center to connect residents ages 17 and older to comprehensive academic, health monitoring, workforce training, and career counseling programs. The New Haven Adult & Continuing Education Center will serve individuals from the city of New Haven and surrounding communities, including eligible individuals with disabilities.
- **Key State Contact:** The City of New Haven in partnership with the New Haven Board of Education

*Connecticut estimates this project will increase enrollment by approximately 5% per year through 2027 to serve **more than 1600 students annually.***
