Treasury approves Connecticut's plan to invest \$5 million of CPF funding in a multi-purpose community facility to improve resources for communities that enable work, education, and health monitoring.

Connecticut Capital Projects Fund Program Overview

- **Program Summary:** \$5 million for a Multi-Purpose Community Facility (4% of CPF allocation)
- **Program Description:** The construction of the Manchester Public Library will provide public Wi-Fi and access to computers connected to the internet. In addition, the Manchester Public Library will include a “Makerspace” to provide community members access to creative equipment and technology (e.g. 3D printers, laser cutters) and include space dedicated to health equity programming and health care.
- **Key State Contact:** Office of School Construction Grants and Review

Connecticut estimates this project will serve over 200,000 visitors per year.
