Kansas Capital Projects Fund Program Overview

- Program Summary: \$70.4 million for Multi-Purpose Community Facilities (66% of CPF allocation)
- Program Description: The construction or improvement of five community facilities including three libraries, a recreation center, and a senior center, will expand or improve broadband internet

DC estimates these facilities will benefit more than 490,000 residents annually.
