Treasury approves DC's plan to invest \$70.4 million of CPF funding in multi-purpose community facilities to improve resources for communities that enable work, education, and health monitoring.

Kansas Capital Projects Fund Program Overview

- **Program Summary:** \$70.4 million for Multi-Purpose Community Facilities (66% of CPF allocation)
- **Program Description:** The construction or improvement of five community facilities including three libraries, a recreation center, and a senior center, will expand or improve broadband internet access to the public, enabling DC residents to participate in the job market, access educational resources and learning, and receive medical information and telehealth services.

DC estimates these facilities will benefit more than 490,000 residents annually.
