Idaho's Capital Projects Fund Program Overview

- Program Summary: \$3.4 million for Multi-Purpose Community Facilities (3% of CPF allocation)
- Program Description: Idaho's Commission for Libraries Facility Program is a competitive grant program that provides funding to eligible libraries to upgrade or expand facilities to meet the needs of identified communities. Public libraries funded through this

Idaho estimates that this program will fund improvements to at least **23 libraries**.

program will provide increased access to resources and programming for community members including students, job seekers, and families, among others.
