Kansas

Treasury approves Kansas's plan to invest \$38.5 million of CPF funding in multi-purpose community facilities to improve resources for communities that enable work, education, and health monitoring.

Kansas Capital Projects Fund Program Overview

- **Program Summary:** \$38.5 million for Multi-Purpose Community Facilities (27% of CPF allocation)
- **Program Description:** The Community-Driven Grants for Multi-Purpose Community Facility Expansion grant program provides funding to build or renovate multi-purpose community facilities that provide expanded access to broadband and digital connectivity devices for communities. These facilities may include computer labs for searching and applying for employment opportunities and accessing tele-health appointments, and meeting rooms for classes (including job skills, continuing education, parenting).
- **Key State Contact:** Kansas Children's Cabinet and Trust Fund

Kansas estimates this program will fund approximately 10 facilities.

On October 2, 2024, Treasury approved Kansas' request to modify the funding to \$38.5M. This fact sheet reflects those changes.
