



# Capital Projects Fund Award Fact Sheet

## *Massachusetts*

*Treasury approves Massachusetts' plan to invest \$21.6 million of CPF funding in broadband infrastructure projects that will provide high-quality internet to locations that lack access to adequate service.*

### Massachusetts Capital Projects Fund Program Overview

- **Program Summary:** \$21.6 million for Broadband Infrastructure (12% of CPF allocation)
- **Locations to Be Served:** 18,000 housing units (estimated)
- **Program Description:** The Residential Internet Retrofit program is a competitive grant program that will fund projects designed to remedy issues with the quality of residential internet service and make long-term investments to ensure residents of participating affordable housing developments have access to reliable high-speed internet.
  - This program is designed to provide internet service with speeds of 100/100 Mbps upon project completion.
  - Internet service providers utilizing investments funded by CPF will be required to participate in the FCC's [Affordable Connectivity Program \(ACP\)](#) – a \$30 per month subsidy for low-income families.
