## GENERAL OVERVIEW

### **Executive Summary**

The American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, signed by the president on March 12, 2021, included the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF) meant to provide support to state and local government to respond in controlling the pandemic, replacing lost revenue, supporting economic stabilization for households and businesses, and addressing the unequal impact of the pandemic on public health and economic challenges.

Under this funding, the City of Miami (“City”) has been allocated about \$137 million, of which about \$69 million has been received to date. The City is currently working with its City Commission and residents in the selection of programs and projects that will promote equitable outcomes. Some of the programs and projects being reviewed include housing development, homeless prevention and infrastructure projects to make the City more resilient.

### **Uses of Funds**
