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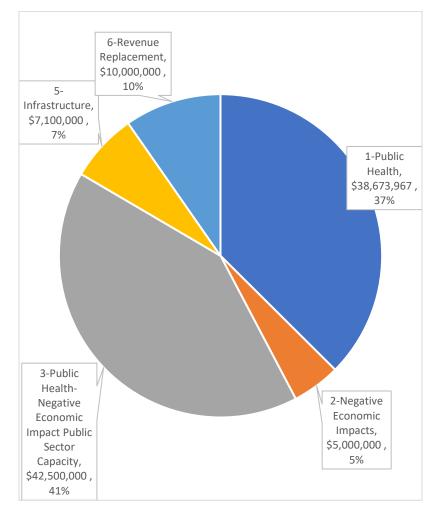
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GENERAL OVERVIEW

Executive Summary

Montgomery County, Ohio received \$103,273,967 in State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF). Funding has been allocated over a wide range of areas including medical expenses related to COVID-19, Public safety personnel, support and improvement for the care of our most vulnerable population and investments in our infrastructure including Broadband, water and sewer assets.

As of 6/30/2022, the county has obligated \$4,477,082.94 and has expensed \$2,519,879.50 of the SLFRF funds.



Uses of Funds

- Public Health (EC 1) This category includes an allocation to the improvement of air quality in main county facilities, renovation of county facilities that serve the county population, reimbursement for COVID-19 related costs the county Health Fund and Public Health Department.
- Negative Economic Impacts (EC 2) This allocation is for economic development initiatives in the form of grants to address impacts of the pandemic, with special emphasis on small, minority owned businesses
- Public Health-Negative Economic Impact: Public Sector Capacity (EC 3) This allocation addresses payroll costs for public safety personnel.
- Water, sewer, and broadband infrastructure (EC 5) This allocation is specifically for broadband expansion into the county's rural areas as well as improvements to the county's water and sewer system, specifically a new Environmental Lab and emergency water equipment.
- Revenue Replacement EC 6) This allocation is for replacing lost revenue in the County General Fund and will be used for government services.

Promoting equitable outcomes

Montgomery County has dedicated SLFRF funding to assist small, minority owned businesses adversely affected by the pandemic. These businesses will be identified by the economic development department and promotion through the county website.

Community Engagement

Montgomery County will task our Communications team to develop community engagement strategies.

Labor Practices

Montgomery County adheres to all applicable federal labor law. Additionally, through procurement policies and procedures the County adheres to all labor laws on contracts for projects.

Use of Evidence

Montgomery County is in the process of procuring legal services to incorporate program evaluation into the SLFRF program.
