



# Capital Projects Fund Award Fact Sheet

## Nebraska

*Treasury approves Nebraska's plan to invest \$35 million of CPF funding in multi-purpose community facilities to improve resources for communities that enable work, education, and health monitoring.*

### Nebraska Capital Projects Fund Program Overview

- **Program Summary:** \$35 million for Multi-Purpose Community Facilities (27% of CPF allocation)
- **Program Description:** The Multi-Purpose Community Facility Program will provide funding for multi-use community facilities in Omaha. Facilities will be tailored to the community's needs but at a minimum will provide a space to (1) apply for jobs on public access computers or partner with an employment search assistance program for on-site services, (2) provide space for individuals to access educational opportunities or provide resources and opportunities for apprenticeships/internships with non-profit organizations, and (3) provide access to health monitoring resources or space with public Wi-Fi where individuals can access telehealth services.
- **Key State Contact:** Department of Economic Development (DED)

*Nebraska estimates that this program will fund facilities serving the entire population of Omaha, an estimated 486,500 individuals.*
