Treasury approves Nebraska's plan to invest \$35 million of CPF funding in multi-purpose community facilities to improve resources for communities that enable work, education, and health monitoring.

Nebraska Capital Projects Fund Program Overview

- Program Summary: \$35 million for Multi-Purpose Community Facilities (27% of CPF allocation)
- Program Description: The Multi-Purpose Community Facility Program will provide funding for multi-use community facilities in Omaha. Facilities will be tailored to the community's needs but at a minimum will provide a space to (1) apply for jobs on public access computers or partner with an

Nebraska estimates that this program will fund facilities serving the entire population of Omaha, an estimated 486,500 individuals.

- employment search assistance program for on-site services, (2) provide space for individuals to access educational opportunities or provide resources and opportunities for apprenticeships/internships with non-profit organizations, and (3) provide access to health monitoring resources or space with public Wi-Fi where individuals can access telehealth services.
