- Program Summary: \$15 million for Digital Connectivity Technology (8% of CPF allocation)
- Program Description: The NJ TRANSIT Connected Bus program aims to address the inequity in broadband access through provision of free high-speed Wi-Fi onboard public transport buses. The provision of Wi-Fi onboard public transit will directly enable work, education, and health monitoring by providing access to public Wi-Fi in a setting that may be the only
