Treasury approves New Jersey's plan to invest \$34.4 million of CPF funding in multi-purpose community facilities to improve resources for communities that enable work, education, and health monitoring.

New Jersey Capital Projects Fund Program Overview

- Program Summary: \$34.4 million for Multi-Purpose Community Facilities (18% of CPF allocation)
- Program Description: New Jersey's Community Center Digital Connect Program is a competitive grant program that provides funding to eligible community centers to improve facilities and invest in new digital devices that enable residents to directly connect to work, education, and health monitoring. This program targets spaces that serve as public libraries, municipal or county community facilities, non-profit organizations, full-service community schools, and community health facilities. Additionally, NJ's Community Center Digital Connect Program will prioritize applications that demonstrate support from local communities as well as those with strong community organization partnerships.
