- Program Summary: \$56.8 million for Multi-Purpose Community Facilities (29% of CPF allocation)
- Program Description: New Jersey will use this New Jersey estimates this CPF award to fund the construction of a community project will benefit approximately 10,000 school in Union City. In addition to educating community members students in grades 7-9, the community school will offer programming that enhances adult learning and development after the school day and during weekends.

Examples of programs include computer and technology literacy workshops, English language (ESL) classes, and health screenings.
