- Program Description: New Mexico's Tribal Library Broadband-Ready Facility Improvement Program will fund the construction and improvements to seven libraries and family resource centers within tribal communities to help ensure Native Americans have access to educational programming, health and

The facilities will serve thousands across seven Pueblos, Tribes, and Nations throughout the state.

career services, and social supports in the tribal communities where they live. Upon completion of the projects, all facilities will provide publicly accessible broadband internet and computers to directly enable work, education, and health monitoring within their communities, currently among the state's least served in terms of broadband access.
