



# Capital Projects Fund Award Fact Sheet

## Ohio

*Treasury approves Ohio's plan to invest \$50 million of CPF funding in broadband infrastructure projects that will provide high-quality internet to locations that lack access to adequate service.*

### Ohio's Capital Projects Fund Program Overview

- **Program Summary:** \$50 million for Broadband Infrastructure (19% of CPF allocation)
- **Program Description:** The Multi-County Last Mile Fiber Build Pilot program is a broadband grant program designed to provide high-speed, reliable internet in an area of the state with a gap in infrastructure availability and where the cost of the last-mile connection is a barrier.
  - This program is designed to provide internet service with speeds of 100/100 Mbps upon project completion.
  - Internet service providers utilizing investments funded by CPF will be required to participate in the FCC's [Affordable Connectivity Program \(ACP\)](#) – a \$30 per month subsidy for low-income families.

*On June 10, 2024, Treasury approved Ohio's request to modify the funding from \$60M to \$50M. This fact sheet reflects these changes.*
