Treasury approves Ohio's plan to invest \$85 million of CPF funding in multipurpose community facilities to improve resources for communities that enable work, education, and health monitoring.

## **Ohio's Capital Projects Fund Program Overview**

- Program Summary: \$85 million for Multi-Purpose Community Facilities (32% of CPF allocation)
- Program Description: Ohio's Appalachian Community Innovation Campuses Program is a competitive grant program that provides funding to eligible counties within the Appalachian region to construct multi-purpose facilities designed to increase access to education, community health services, and workforce development opportunities. Each campus will provide public education to students across a minimum of six grade levels, health services in partnership with a healthcare provider, and a return-to-work site with internet access.
