Ohio

Treasury approves Ohio's plan to invest \$7 million of CPF funding in broadband infrastructure projects that will provide high-quality internet to locations that lack access to adequate service.

Ohio's Capital Projects Fund Program Overview

- **Program Summary:** \$7 million for Broadband Infrastructure (3% of CPF allocation)
- **Program Description:** The Shovel Ready School District Project is a competitive broadband grant program that provides funding to eligible school districts to expanded connectivity to locations where students and families have been shown to have lower rates of broadband access due to difficult terrain and lack of available funding.
 - This program is designed to provide internet service with speeds of 100/100 Mbps upon project completion.
 - Internet service providers utilizing investments funded by CPF will be required to participate in the FCC's [Affordable Connectivity Program \(ACP\)](#) – a \$30 per month subsidy for low-income families.
