Oregon

Treasury approves Oregon's plan to invest \$149 million of CPF funding in broadband infrastructure projects that will provide high-quality internet to locations that lack access to adequate service.

Oregon Capital Projects Fund Program Overview

- **Program Summary:** \$149 million for Broadband Infrastructure (100% of program allocation)
- **Locations to Be Served:** 17,195 (estimated)
- **Program Description:** The Oregon Broadband Deployment Program (BDP) is a competitive grant program designed to fund last-mile broadband infrastructure in areas of the state lacking internet speeds of 100/20 Mbps. The program will prioritize projects that will provide service to those locations currently lacking service that reliably meets 10/1 Mbps.
 - This program is designed to provide internet service with speeds of 100/100 Mbps upon project completion.
 - Internet service providers utilizing investments funded by CPF will be required to participate in the FCC's [Affordable Connectivity Program \(ACP\)](#) – a \$30 per month subsidy for low-income families.
