Pennsylvania Capital Projects Fund Program Overview

- Program Summary: \$44.9 million for Multi-Purpose Community Facilities (16% of CPF allocation)
- Program Description: Pennsylvania's Digital Anchor Institution Grant Program is a competitive grant program that provides funding to community anchor institutions and local governments for projects to construct, acquire, or improve community facilities that are open to the public. - fund a variety of facilities, including recreation centers, libraries, and community schools. The program will prioritize areas with greatest digital need, particularly those that have been historically marginalized.
