Treasury approves South Dakota's plan to invest \$69.6 million of CPF funding in a multi-purpose community facility to improve resources for communities that enable work, education, and health monitoring.

South Dakota Capital Projects Fund Program Overview

- **Program Summary:** \$69.6 million for a Multi-Purpose Community Facility (60% of CPF allocation)
- **Program Description:** The construction of the Department of Health Workforce Development and Education Center will provide public access to computers and Wi-Fi to enable community members to complete job searches, prepare resumes, submit job applications, and conduct telehealth appointments. The center will also host in-person and virtual programs such as literacy events and career fairs as well as classes across a variety of topics including: safe sleep education for new parents; new parent classes; injury prevention; first aid and CPR; healthy relationships; substance use and abuse; suicide prevention; mental health and resiliency; and senior health and insurance education.
