Treasury approves South Dakota's plan to invest \$29.5 million of CPF funding in a multi-purpose community facility to improve resources for communities that enable work, education, and health monitoring.

South Dakota Capital Projects Fund Program Overview

- Program Summary: \$29.5 million for a Multi-Purpose Community Facility (25% of CPF allocation)
- Program Description: The construction of Lincoln Hall will provide Northern State University with expanded space to house the NSU School of Business and the South Dakota State University (SDSU) Accelerated Nursing program as well as flexible space for community use and programming, including career fairs, healthcare clinics, and a start-

The facility is designed to serve the entire northeast corner of South Dakota, a population of more than 28,000 individuals.

including career fairs, healthcare clinics, and a start-up center for local entrepreneurs. Public access to wireless internet will be available throughout the facility and several private rooms will be equipped with technology to support private interactive telehealth appointments.
