Treasury approves Texas' plan to invest \$7.8 million of CPF funding in multi-purpose community facilities to improve resources for communities that enable work, education, and health monitoring.

Texas' Capital Projects Fund Program Overview

- **Program Summary:** \$7.8 million for Multi-Purpose Community Facilities (2% of CPF allocation)
- **Program Description:** The Library Infrastructure and Facility Access Improvement Grant (IFAIG) program is a competitive grant program that provides funding to public libraries for infrastructure construction projects related to broadband expansion and digital inclusion. The IFAIG program will prioritize public libraries located in areas that fall below median national income levels, are rural, or lack adequate connectivity.

Texas estimates this program will fund improvements to 85 libraries, serving approximately 1,020,000 community members
