



# Capital Projects Fund Award Fact Sheet

## Utah

*Treasury approves Utah's plan to invest \$19.3 million of CPF funding in broadband infrastructure projects that will provide high-quality internet to locations that lack access to adequate service.*

### Utah's Capital Projects Fund Program Overview

- **Program Summary:** \$19.3 million for Broadband Infrastructure (14% of CPF allocation)
- **Program Description:** The Utah Education and Telehealth Network Infrastructure Upgrade Project will fund the construction of middle mile infrastructure serving community anchor institutions (CAIs) currently lacking access to reliable internet service that delivers speeds of 100/20 Mbps. The Project will modernize network infrastructure to support schools, libraries, and health clinics.
  - This program is designed to provide internet service with speeds of 100/100 Mbps upon project completion.
  - Internet service providers utilizing investments funded by CPF will be required to participate in the FCC's [Affordable Connectivity Program \(ACP\)](#) – a \$30 per month subsidy for low-income families.
