Utah

Treasury approves Utah's plan to invest \$7 million of CPF funding in multi-purpose community facilities to improve resources for communities that enable work, education, and health monitoring.

Utah Capital Projects Fund Program Overview

- **Program Summary:** \$7 million for Multi-Purpose Community Facilities (5% of CPF allocation)
- **Program Description:** The construction of a community campus in Box Elder County that includes a family center, crisis shelter, and nonprofit community space. The facility will be used to provide educational opportunities, including academic remediation and tutoring, workforce skills classes for teens and adults, and health screenings.
- **Key State Contact:** Division of Child and Family Services of the Utah Department of Health and Human Services

Utah estimates that the community campus will serve more than 3,500 individuals annually.
