Wyoming's Capital Projects Fund Program Overview

- Program Summary: \$12.4 million for a Multi-Purpose Community Facility (11% of CPF allocation)
- Program Description: The construction of Central Wyoming College (CWC) Jackson campus facilities will support educational needs in the areas of healthcare, early childhood education, hospitality, and English as a Second Language. Additionally, the campus facilities will provide programming and services to support the broader community, such as a career office, career fairs, and workshops open to all. The campus facilities will provide public access to computer labs and high-speed wireless internet. The campus facilities will host public health fairs and clinics for the community and provide open access to private telehealth rooms for virtual mental health counseling and telemedicine appointments.
