


#### TREASURY OPERATING CASH BALANCE





### TREASURY NET MARKET BORROWING<sup>1</sup>




## NEW MONEY RAISED IN BILLS AS A PERCENT OF TOTAL NET MARKET BORROWING





## QUARTERLY CHANGES IN FOREIGN AND INTERNATIONAL HOLDINGS OF PUBLIC DEBT SECURITIES





### SHORT TERM INTEREST RATES










### **MARKET YIELDS ON GOVERNMENTS**




# PRESENT TREASURY YIELD FORMULAS VS. ALTERNATIVE YIELD FORMULAS



## PRIVATE HOLDINGS OF TREASURY MARKETABLE DEBT BY MATURITY




### PRIVATE HOLDINGS OF TREASURY MARKETABLE DEBT BY MATURITY




#### TREASURY MARKETABLE MATURITIES

Privately Held, Excluding Bills and Exchange Notes



### NET NEW MONEY IN AGENCY FINANCE, QUARTERLY




