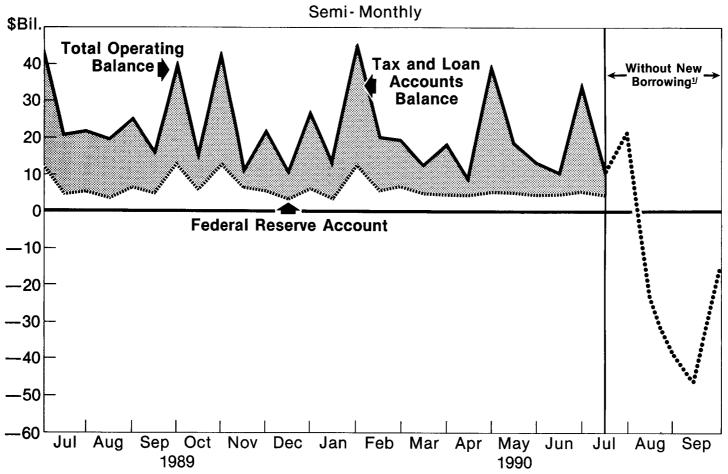

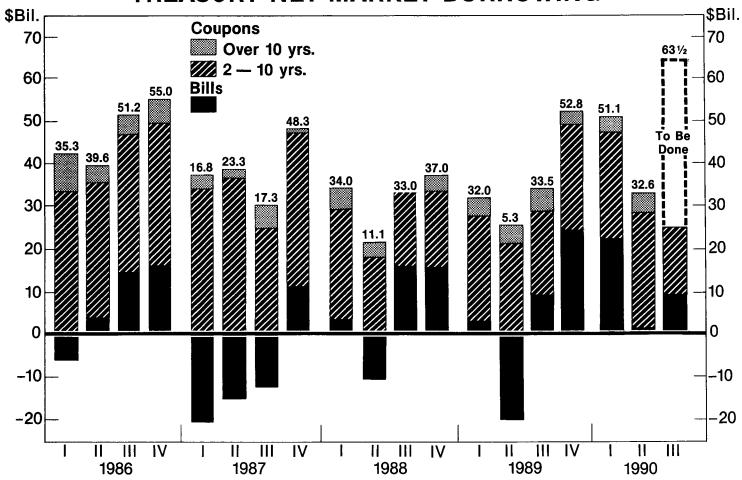

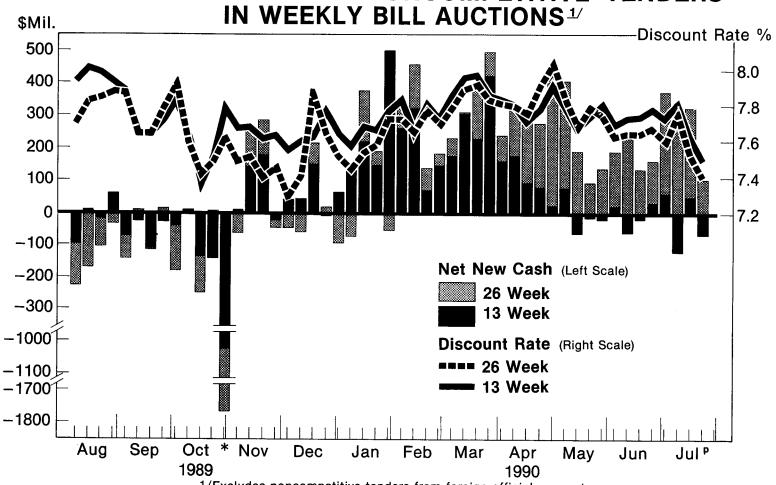
## TREASURY NET MARKET BORROWING<sup>1</sup>/

## NET NEW CASH FROM NONCOMPETITIVE TENDERS IN WEEKLY BILL AUCTIONS 1/2



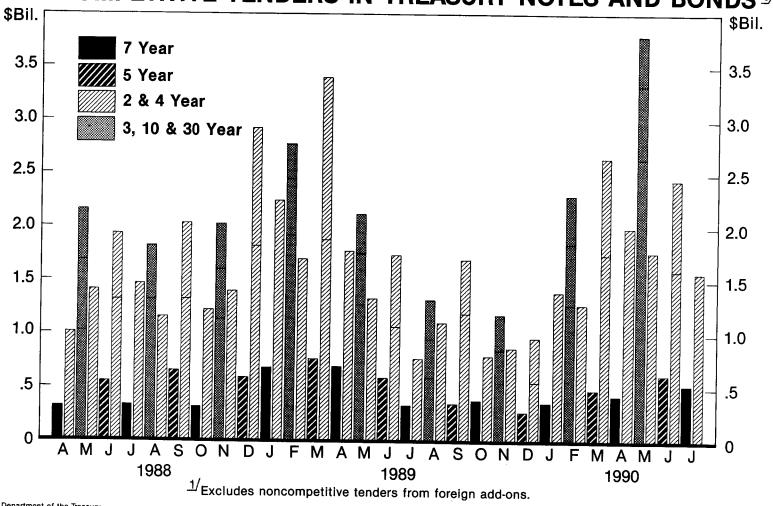

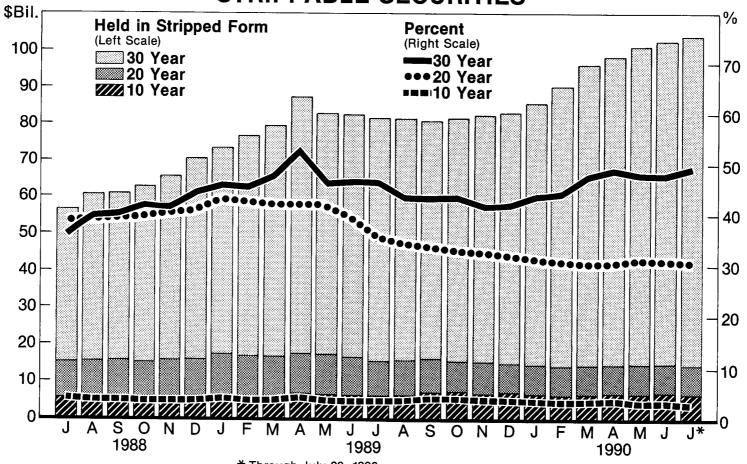

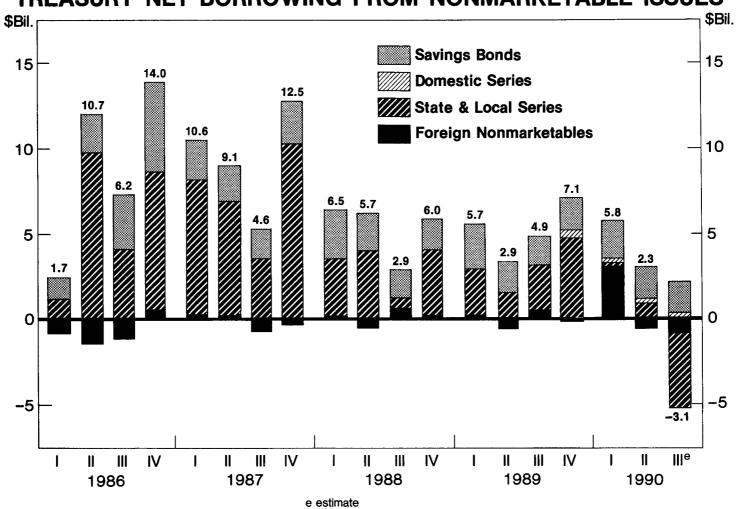


# NET STRIPS AS A PERCENT OF PRIVATELY HELD STRIPPABLE SECURITIES

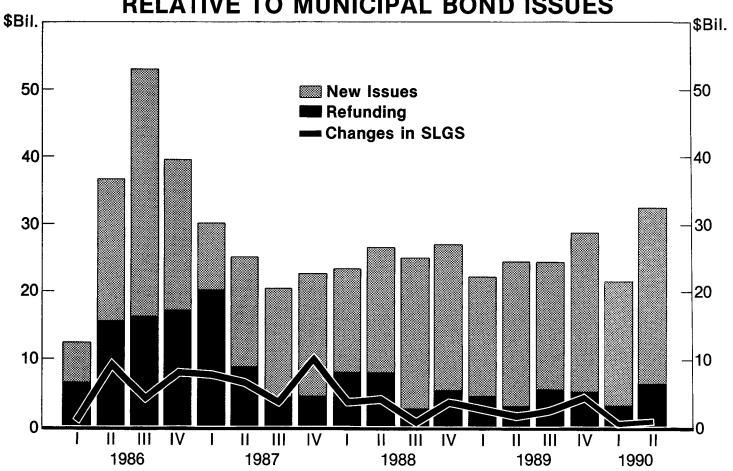

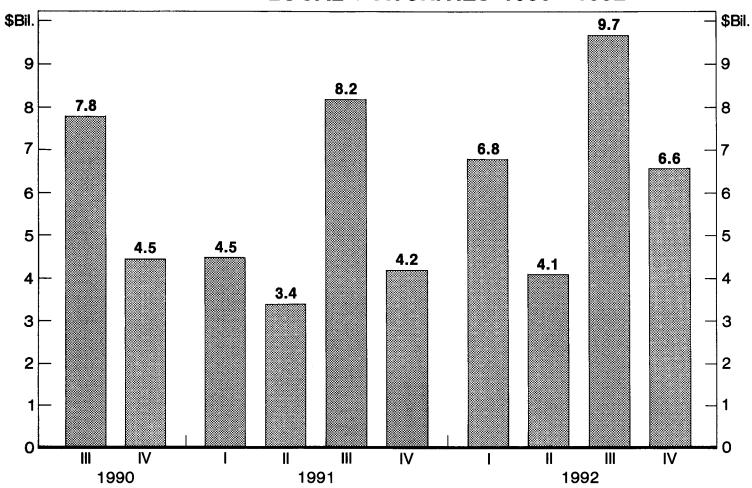
### TREASURY NET BORROWING FROM NONMARKETABLE ISSUES



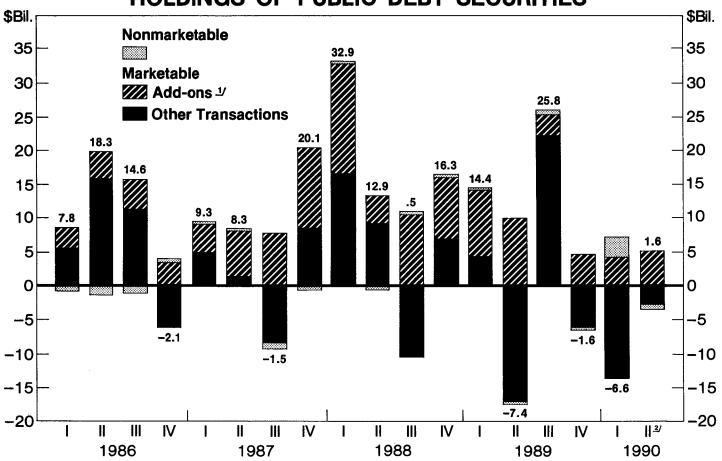
## CHANGES IN STATE & LOCAL GOVERNMENT SERIES RELATIVE TO MUNICIPAL BOND ISSUES



## STATE AND LOCAL MATURITIES 1990—1992



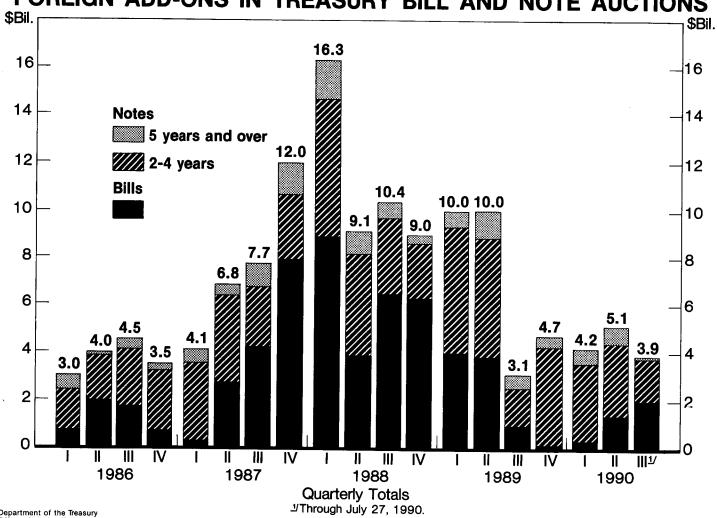
## QUARTERLY CHANGES IN FOREIGN AND INTERNATIONAL HOLDINGS OF PUBLIC DEBT SECURITIES

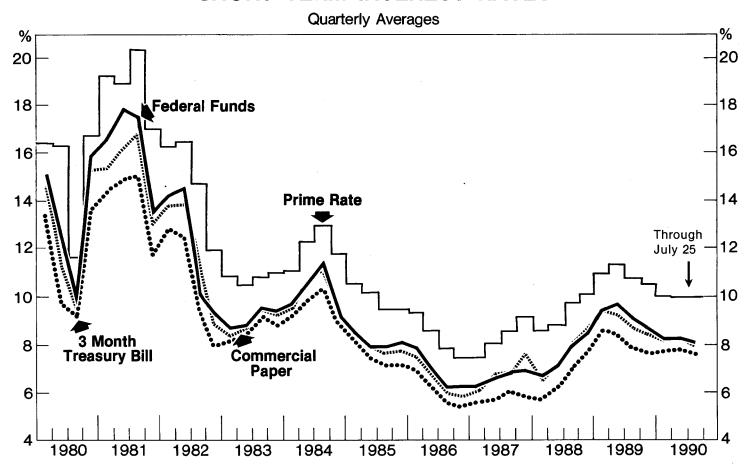
## FOREIGN ADD-ONS IN TREASURY BILL AND NOTE AUCTIONS



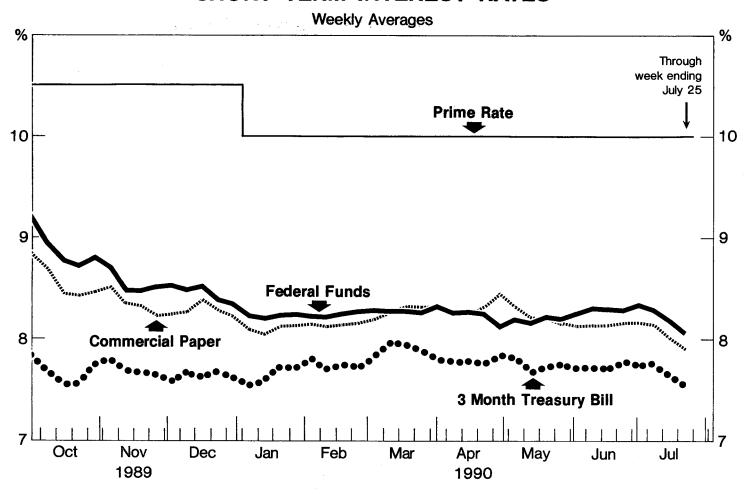

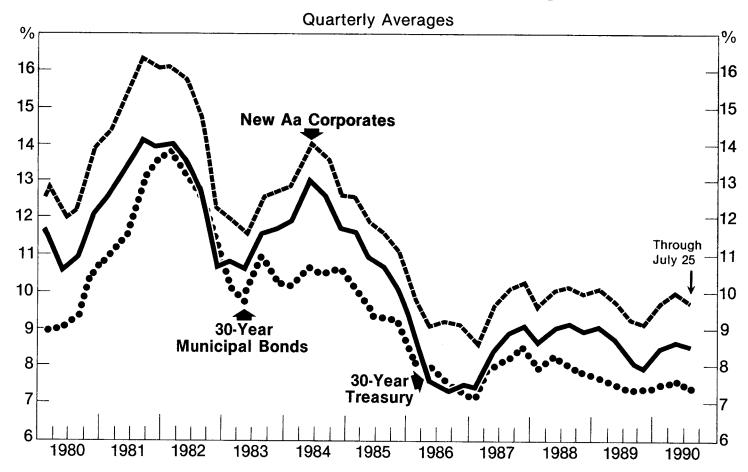
#### SHORT TERM INTEREST RATES



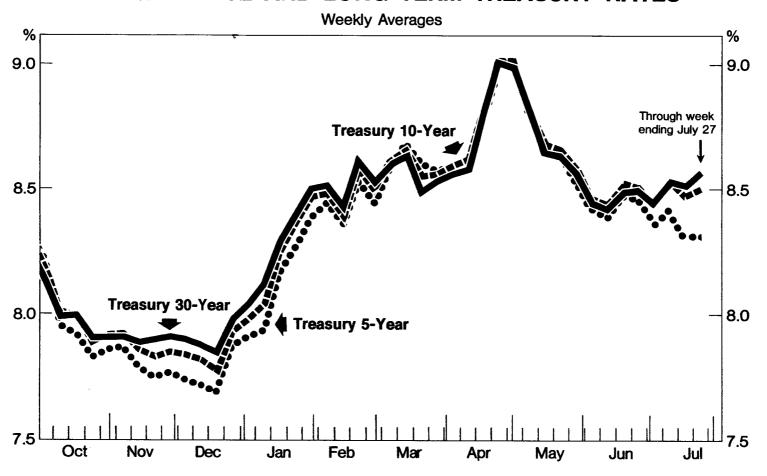

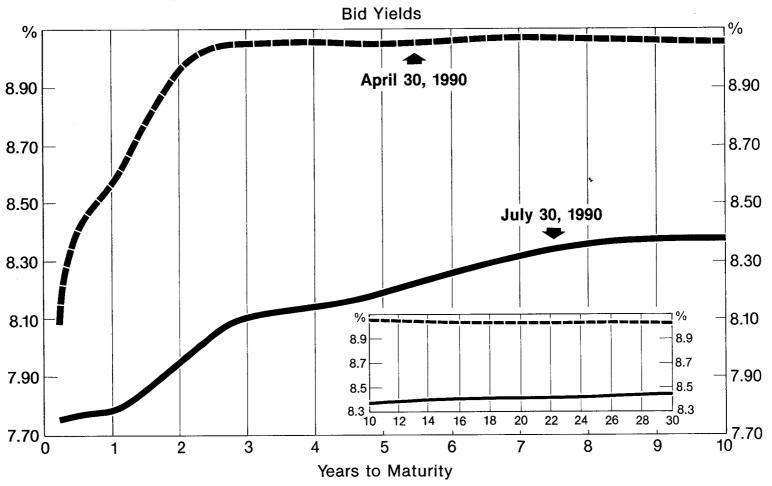

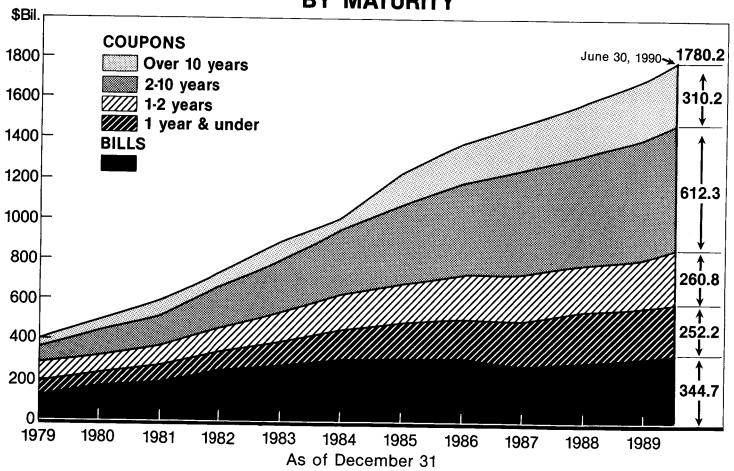

### MARKET YIELDS ON GOVERNMENTS

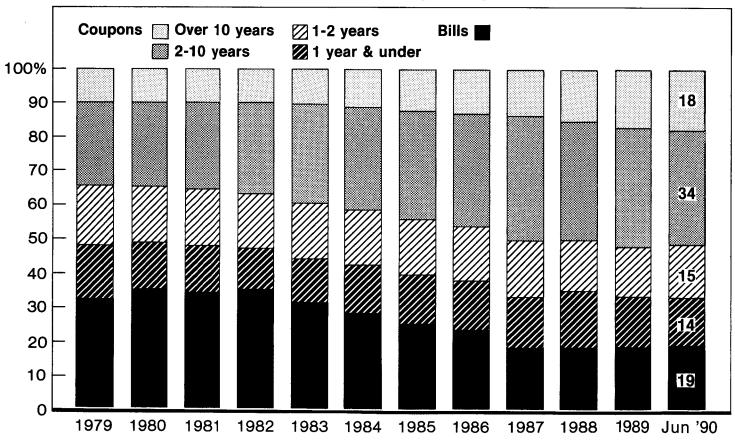


## PRIVATE HOLDINGS OF TREASURY MARKETABLE DEBT BY MATURITY



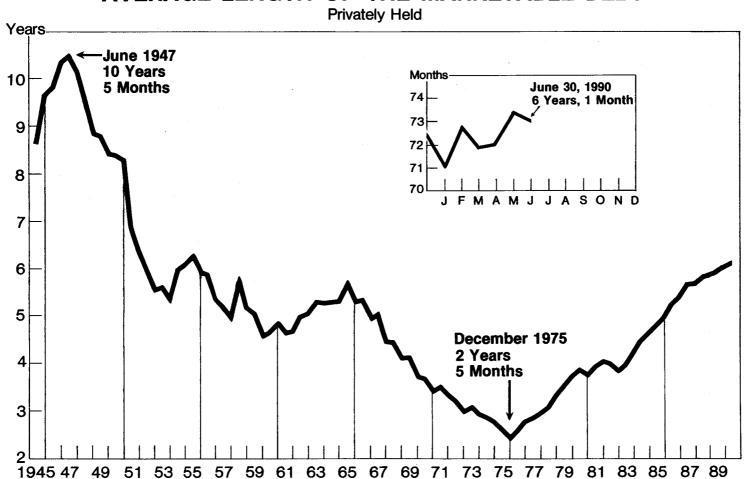

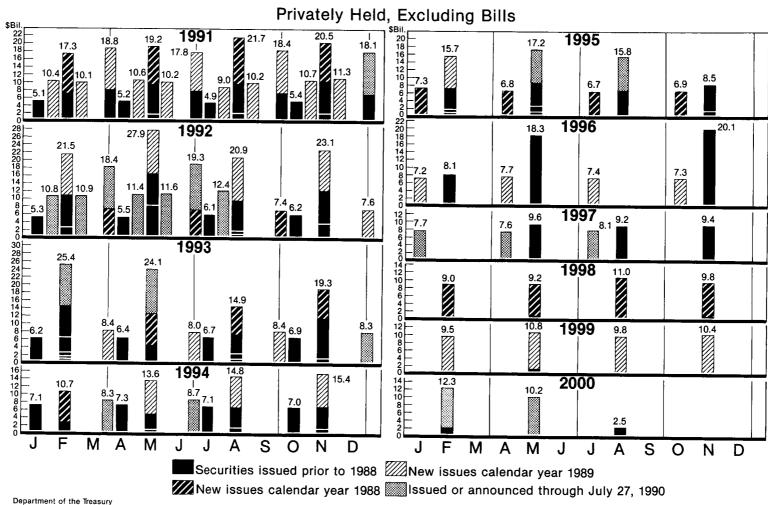

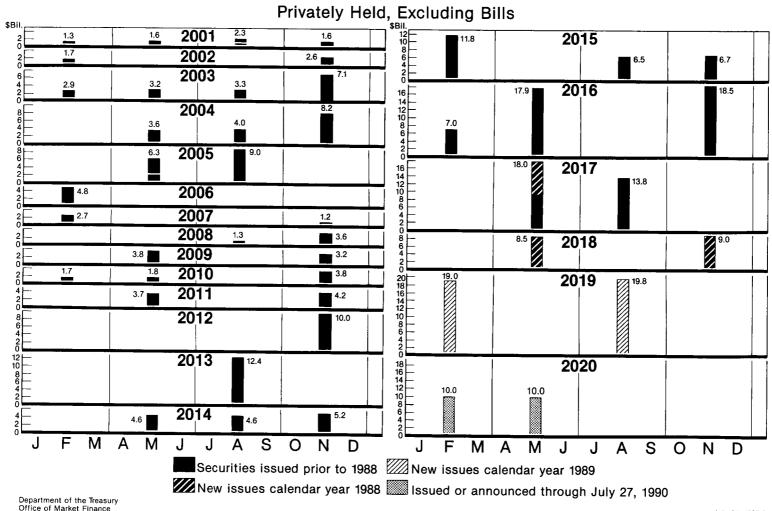
