


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#### TREASURY OPERATING CASH BALANCE

# TREASURY NET MARKET BORROWING 1/



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
#### **AWARDS IN WEEKLY BILL AUCTIONS**







#### **AWARDS IN 52-WEEK BILL AUCTIONS**





#### NONCOMPETITIVE TENDERS IN TREASURY NOTES AND BONDS 1/







# NET STRIPS AS A PERCENT OF PRIVATELY HELD STRIPPABLE SECURITIES




### **SECURITIES HELD IN STRIPS FORM**

#### SALES OF UNITED STATES SAVINGS BONDS












#### NET AWARDS TO FOREIGN OFFICIAL ACCOUNTS 1/




#### **LONG TERM MARKET RATES**





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#### MARKET YIELDS ON GOVERNMENTS




#### PRIVATE HOLDINGS OF TREASURY MARKETABLE DEBT BY MATURITY


#### PRIVATE HOLDINGS OF TREASURY MARKETABLE DEBT


Percent Distribution By Maturity




#### TREASURY MARKETABLE MATURITIES

Privately held, Excluding Bills


