Welcome to the U.S. Department of the Treasury's Clean Energy Storytelling Program!

We created the Clean Energy Storytelling Program to invite individuals, workers, businesses, tax-exempt organizations, and other eligible taxpayers to voluntarily share their stories about how the Inflation Reduction Act's (IRA) clean energy tax incentives are lowering energy costs for families, bringing back and strengthening manufacturing, and creating good-paying jobs across the country. Our goal is to educate more Americans using some of the best examples around: stories from other people and organizations who are pursuing and benefitting from these incentives.

Storytelling is part of our national fabric. Think about the last time you heard from a neighbor about their home renovations or from a friend about a new job. Multiply that across the homes, jobs, businesses, and non-profits that power our economy, and you'll have an idea of how we'd like to spread the word. By sharing your story about using Treasury's clean energy incentives, you'll help us inform others and share the news.

**How You Can Participate and How Treasury May Share Your Story**

First, and foremost, we need your consent to participate in Treasury's Clean Energy Storytelling Program.

**Participation is entirely voluntary.**

- If you or your organization chooses to participate, the information you provide about your organization, project or purchased product, and relevant tax incentive may be fully or partially used in reports or media, posted on [Treasury's public website](#), referenced in public events, or used in other communications.
- This may include public announcements by the Executive Office of the President (the White House) or other federal agencies.
- The information you provide may be included alongside information from other individuals, businesses, or organizations that also choose to participate.
- Treasury officials may contact you using the contact information provided to learn more about your story, your use of the relevant incentives or programs, and how we can best work with you to share your story in our communications.

**Importantly: Information from the Internal Revenue Service (IRS), including information from your tax returns, will not be used in any way to verify, supplement, or otherwise modify the information you provide through Treasury's voluntary Clean Energy Storytelling Program. The only information that would be used in future communications or events by Treasury or other federal agencies as part of the Clean Energy Storytelling Program is the information you voluntarily choose to submit through the Clean Energy Storytelling Program.**

The information provided through the Clean Energy Storytelling Program is not being collected for purposes of considering a taxpayer's Title 26 liability, and information you volunteer to the Clean Energy Storytelling program is not considered protected under 26 U.S.C. Code 6103. Your consent to participate in Treasury's Clean Energy Storytelling Program and is not a consent to disclose tax returns or return information for purposes of 26 U.S.C. Code 6103.

Additionally, participation in Treasury's Clean Energy Storytelling Program or Treasury's decision to share your story will **not**:

- Represent a governmental endorsement of you or your organization, project, or investment.
- Address your eligibility, or your project's or your investment's eligibility, for any tax incentive.
- Prevent the IRS from using any public information in enforcement, including information that may be made public after you provide it to the Clean Energy Storytelling Program.

Treasury cannot provide tax advice, and the Clean Energy Storytelling Program will not do so.

Individuals, businesses, tax-exempt organizations, and others who voluntarily choose to participate in the Clean Energy Storytelling Program should complete, sign, and submit the participation consent form below. **Choosing to participate in these announcements does not affect your eligibility or qualifications for tax incentives.** Treasury will protect any information you share with us; read more about [how Treasury protects your data here](#).
