

File for Free with IRS Direct File

Direct File is now a permanent IRS service that helps people **save time and money** by filing their taxes online, for free, directly with the IRS.

Direct File is safe and easy to use; no fees, no surprises.

Direct File works as well on a smartphone as it does on a laptop, tablet, or desktop computer, and you can file your taxes in English or Spanish in as little as 30 minutes.

Direct File will be available to eligible taxpayers in 25 states, starting on the first day of the 2025 tax filing season:





Does Direct File include support?

Yes – Direct File users can get support through a live chat with dedicated IRS customer service representatives. Support is available in English and Spanish, and it will feature optional additional authentication and verification to allow assistors to provide more information. This year, Direct File users can also try a new chat bot to provide guided help on the eligibility checker.

Can I use Direct File to complete my state return?

Yes – Direct File users who need to file state income taxes will be connected to their state's free online tax tool to complete their filing.
