FILE YOUR TAX RETURN TO GET PRESIDENT TRUMP'S WORKING FAMILIES TAX CUTS

Following the opening of tax season on January 26, tax refunds are projected to increase by an average of approximately \$1,000 per household in 2026 due to President Trump's Working Families Tax Cuts, with over 100 million households receiving a refund.

Claim President Trump's new tax cuts and permanent tax relief on your return

- 🏆 44 million working families will see an average tax cut of \$1,000 because of No Tax on Tips, No Tax on Overtime, No Tax on Social Security, and No Tax on Car Loan Interest for American-made vehicles
- 🏆 Average of \$1,700 tax cut for 7.5 million American families with two children because of the enhanced Child Tax Credit and other relief in the Working Families Tax Cuts
 - The WFTC boosted the Child Tax Credit to \$2,200 and adjusted for inflation
- 🏆 Filing season has been permanently made easier thanks to the Working Families Tax Cuts doubling the standard deduction
 - The standard deduction is used by over 90% of American taxpayers
- 🏆 44 million American families with children under the age of 18 can file IRS Form 4547 to open their child's Trump Account
