HOW HAS THE CHILD TAX CREDIT CHANGED THIS YEAR?

The American
Rescue Plan
expanded the credit
to get more help to
families

Children under age 6: Amount increased from \$2,000 in 2020 to \$3,600

Children age 6 through 17: Amount increased from \$2,000 in 2020 to \$3,000

Automatic monthly payments instead of oncea-year payments, up to \$300/child under age 6 and \$250/child ages 6 to 17, for the rest of 2021

Families will get the remainder of the credit when they file their taxes next year

Previously, low-income families did not get the same amount or sometimes any of the Child Tax Credit. Now, all families in need will get the full amount.
